\*Diploma holders who have passed the diploma course in Engg. with minimum of 50% marks from the Polytechnics affiliated to MSBTE or AICTE approved autonomous polytechnics in Maharashtra State or outside Maharashtra state.

Students who have not appeared for MHT-CET 2008 may also apply. If seats remain vacant, those students shall be considered for admission.

### **Note:**

**Interim fee will be increased as per fee fixation by Shikshan Shulka Samiti. Fees, as fixed by Shikshan Shulka Samitti, will have to be paid by all the Students.**

- Fees should be paid in the form of Demand Draft/Pay Order in favor of “Principal, Gharda Institute of Technology, Lavel” payable at Chiplun.
- University fees / Examination fees will be as per university guidelines from time to time.

### **E.B.C. Concession :**

Candidates claiming concessions for Economically Backward Class (E.B.C.) shall have to produce a certificate from the Executive Magistrate to the effect that the candidate belongs to EBC category at the time of admission. **(The income limit is revised to Rs. 1 Lakh/Annum)**. They shall, on admission, also submit an application in the prescribed form for being granted the concession of free education, to the appropriate authorities through the college within one month from the actual date of joining of college or as may be required. The students shall note that applications received after the due date may not be considered and in that case, they will have to pay the necessary fees.

EBC Candidates are required to pay 50% of the tuition fees, examination and other fees at the time of confirming admission secured through CAP rounds. The remaining 50% of tuition fees of such candidates will be reimbursed by the concerned dept. to the Institute.

In case, if concerned dept. doesn't reimburse the same, the candidates will have to pay all balance fees / dues.

**Note :-** As per GR No: TEM-2006/ (353/06)TE-1, dated 21 March 2007, the income limit for E.B.C. candidates is revised to Rs. 1 Lakh/Annum.

**Concession for Sons and Daughters of teaching and Non-teaching staff of Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools :**

Not applicable till clarification from concerned Government dept. authority is received.

**Concession in Fees for Backward Class Category Candidates (belonging to Maharashtra State only)**

**For SC/ST/VJ DT/ NT (A) / NT (B)/ NT (C)/ NT (D)/SBC/OBC category candidates**

As per the relevant circulars from the Social and Tribal Welfare Departments, Govt. of Maharashtra, Backward Class Category Candidates belonging to **SC/ST/VJ DT/ NT (A) / NT (B)/ NT (C)/ NT (D)/SBC/OBC** categories securing admission to Un-aided Institutes **through CAP rounds** only are eligible for obtaining reimbursement of the fees approved by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti (SSS), Mumbai. However, these candidates will get reimbursement in fees to the extent of waiver, as notified in the Circulars issued by the Social Justice and Tribal Welfare Departments from time to time, subject to fulfillment of various norms and conditions laid down by these Departments. Details of the fees concession, amount of waiver, documents needed are as follow :

**Note :**

- ❖ Candidates claiming for fee concession under reservation category shall have to produce the requisite certificates as specified by the respective Social Justice and Tribal Welfare Departments.
- ❖ Candidates belonging to **OBC Category** are required to pay 50% of the fees approved by Shikshan Shulka Samiti (SSS) at the time of confirming admission secured through CAP rounds. The remaining 50% fees of such candidates will be reimbursed by the concerned Social Justice and Tribal Welfare department to the Institute. If concerned dept. does not reimburse the fees for any reason, the candidates will have to pay all balance fees /dues.

### **Seats Distribution**

As per DTE rules, seats will be distributed for CAP & Institute Level Admissions. The seats remaining vacant after reporting of students from CAP rounds shall be filled in by Institute in the Institute level round (vacancy round).

### **Allotment of Course**

Allotment of course will be made on merit-cum-option basis. As per merit list, option of courses shall be considered & allotted.
